Cynthia L. Bauerly is an attorney in Washington, D.C. From late 2005 through 2007, Ms. Bauerly served as Legislative Director for Senator Charles E. Schumer of New York. She directed all aspects of the Senator's legislative agenda by setting and implementing legislative priorities, managing policy staff, advising the Senator on floor strategy, campaign finance and ethics policy, overseeing committee and subcommittee activities, and coordinating with communications staff.

In 2004 and 2005, Ms. Bauerly practiced intellectual property and business litigation with the firm of Fredrikson & Byron in Minneapolis, Minnesota. From February until November of 2005, she served as Policy Director for the Amy Klobuchar for United States Senate campaign.

From 2002 until 2004, Ms. Bauerly served as Senator Schumer's Counsel on the Judiciary and Rules Committees. As Counsel she advised the Senator on a broad range of policy matters including election reform, campaign finance, technology, telecommunications, intellectual property, antitrust, legal process reform, and immigration.

Prior to her work for Senator Schumer, she practiced complex litigation and appellate law at Jones Day in Washington, D.C. She served as a judicial clerk for the Honorable Florence-Marie Cooper of the United States District Court for the Central District of California and the Honorable Theodore R. Boehm of the Indiana Supreme Court.

Ms. Bauerly received her Bachelor of Arts *summa cum laude* from Concordia College in Moorhead, Minnesota, her Juris Doctor *cum laude* from Indiana University School of Law at Bloomington and her Master of Public Affairs from Indiana University School of Public and Environmental Affairs.
