Trevor Potter is the founder and President of Campaign Legal Center (CLC), a Washington, D.C.based nonpartisan nonprofit that participates in legal proceedings across the country to defend the right to vote, improve the disclosure and regulation of campaign finance, and promote high ethical standards in government.

Potter is a former Republican Chairman of the Federal Election Commission and was General Counsel to John McCain's 2000 and 2008 presidential campaigns. To many, he is perhaps best known for his recurring <u>appearances</u> on The Colbert Report as the lawyer for Stephen Colbert's super PAC during the 2012 election. The American Bar Association Journal has described Potter as "hands-down one of the top lawyers in the country on the delicate intersection of politics, law and money."

Potter has recently appeared on CBS's <u>60 Minutes</u> with Anderson Cooper, on CBS's morning news show <u>Face the Nation</u>, on NBC's <u>Nightly News</u>, and in the films Dark Money (2018) and The King (2017). His writing has been featured in publications such as <u>The Washington Post</u> and <u>The Hill</u>.
