OPENING STATEMENT OF HONORABLE ROY BLUNT, CHAIRMAN, A U.S. SENATOR FROM THE STATE OF MISSOURI

Chairman BLUNT. Thank you for attending today's meeting of the Senate Committee on Rules to consider the nomination of James Brett Blanton to be the Architect of the Capitol.

Chairman BLUNT. Ranking member, ranking member? Do we have a ranking member?

Chairman BLUNT. Okay. If there is no further debate on the nomination of James Brett Blanton to be Architect of the Capitol? [No response.]

Chairman BLUNT. Appears to be none. Calling the question. No further debate on James Brett Blanton to be Architect of the Capitol.

The question is on reporting the nomination favorably to the Senate.

Chairman BLUNT. The ayes have it. The nomination is ordered favorably reported to the Senate with the recommendation the nominee be confirmed.
